### **Gedeon Richter Alerts Job Seekers to Protect Themselves from Scam Email Campaigns**

Gedeon Richter PLC and its related entities and affiliates, (collectively, “Gedeon Richter”), recently became aware of internet scams by persons claiming to offer jobs with Gedeon Richter. Gedeon Richter urges job seekers and applicants to be wary of clicking on strange emails and websites and/or interacting with people or companies seeking information regarding bank accounts, such as for instance online banking passwords, in response to job search or application. Unsolicited emails or text messages and job postings on websites other than Gedeon Richter’s website intend to lure potential victims and prompt them to provide valuable personal and financial information. Armed with this information, criminals can commit identity theft or financial theft.

These are scams designed to capture personal and banking information which are designed to appear as if they are from Gedeon Richter. Gedeon Richter does NOT ask for bank related information from job seekers or applicants or remit any checks to newly hired employees asking to use those funds to make purchases in connection with the new job. Recently, a Harrison James, acting as Gedeon Richter’s employee, approached job seekers and applicants or created or used websites to advertise job openings with Gedeon Richter, and even contacted job seekers and applicants via email or text message. Harrison James is not an employee of Gedeon Richter and is not authorized to act on behalf of Gedeon Richter.

- DO NOT reply to emails or text messages
- DO NOT supply any information concerning your financial status or any bank information, as Gedeon Richter never requests such information
- DO NOT open attachments which arrive with emails

Gedeon Richter is working with the relevant authorities to investigate the fraud.
